

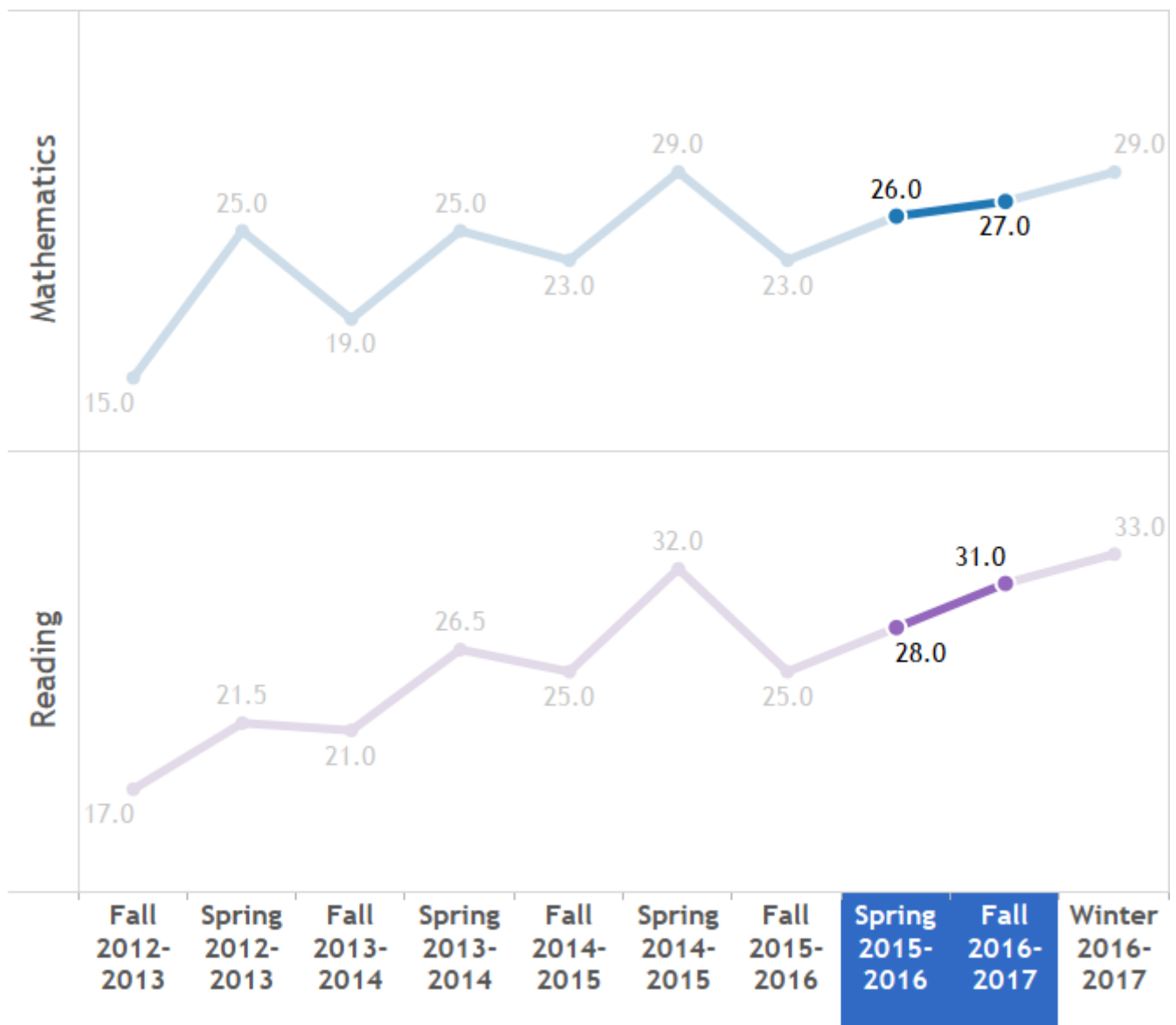

1. For the first time since inception, SDA broke the national trend of summer slump

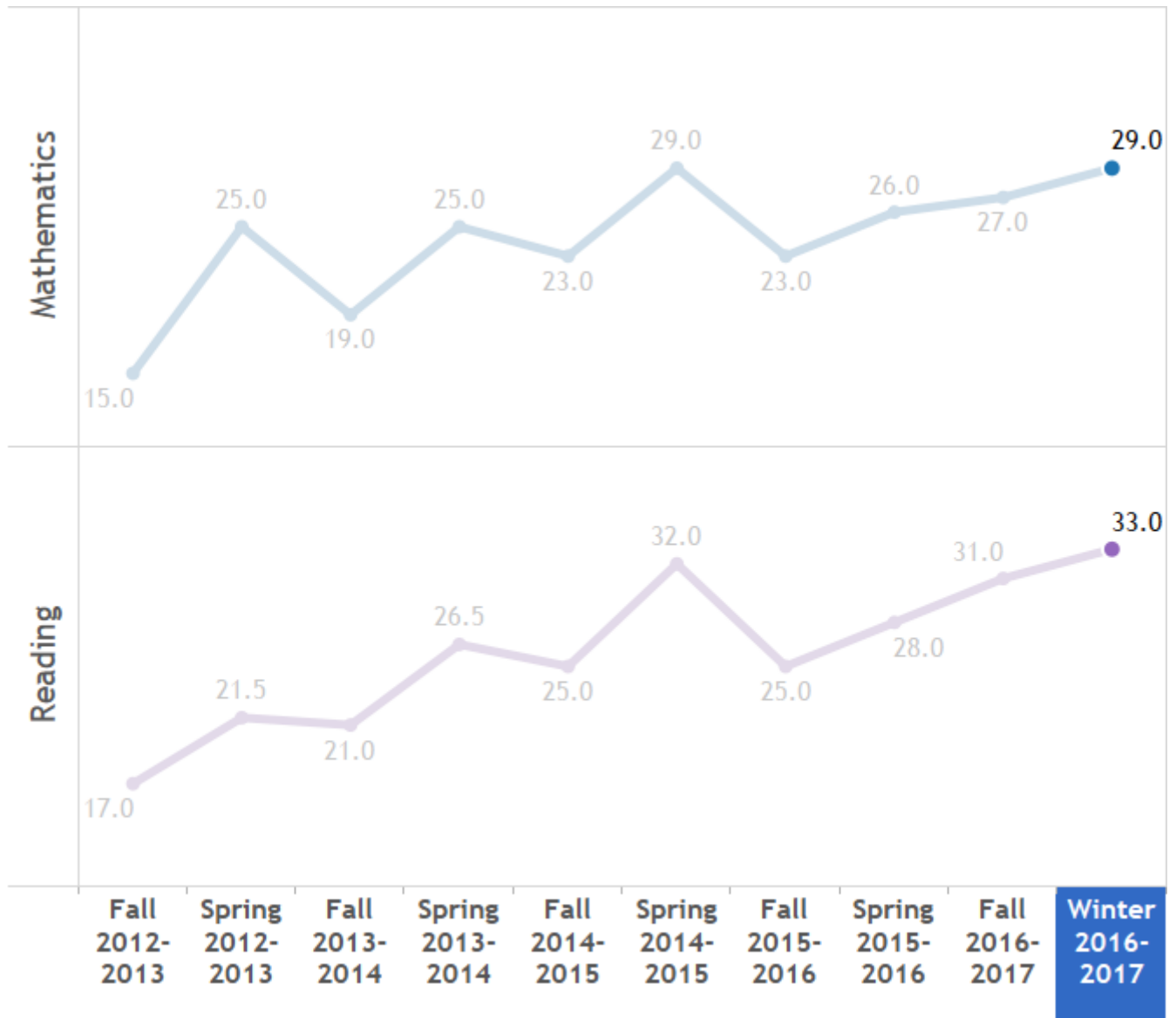
From Spring to Fall:

- i. NWEA Math percentile increased 1 point
- ii. NWEA Reading percentile increased 3 points

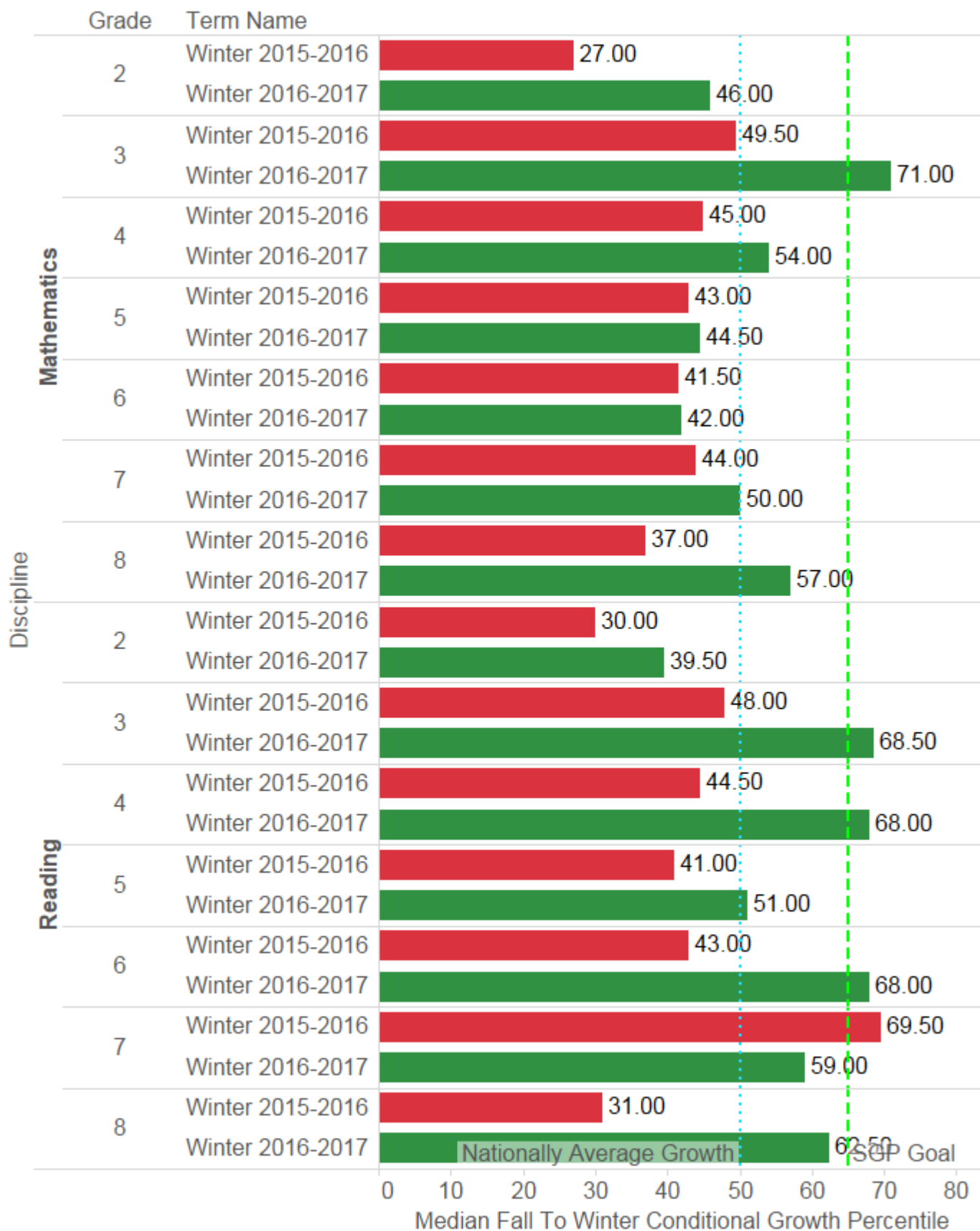


2. Percentile increase continued due to our tremendous Fall to Winter NWEA growth

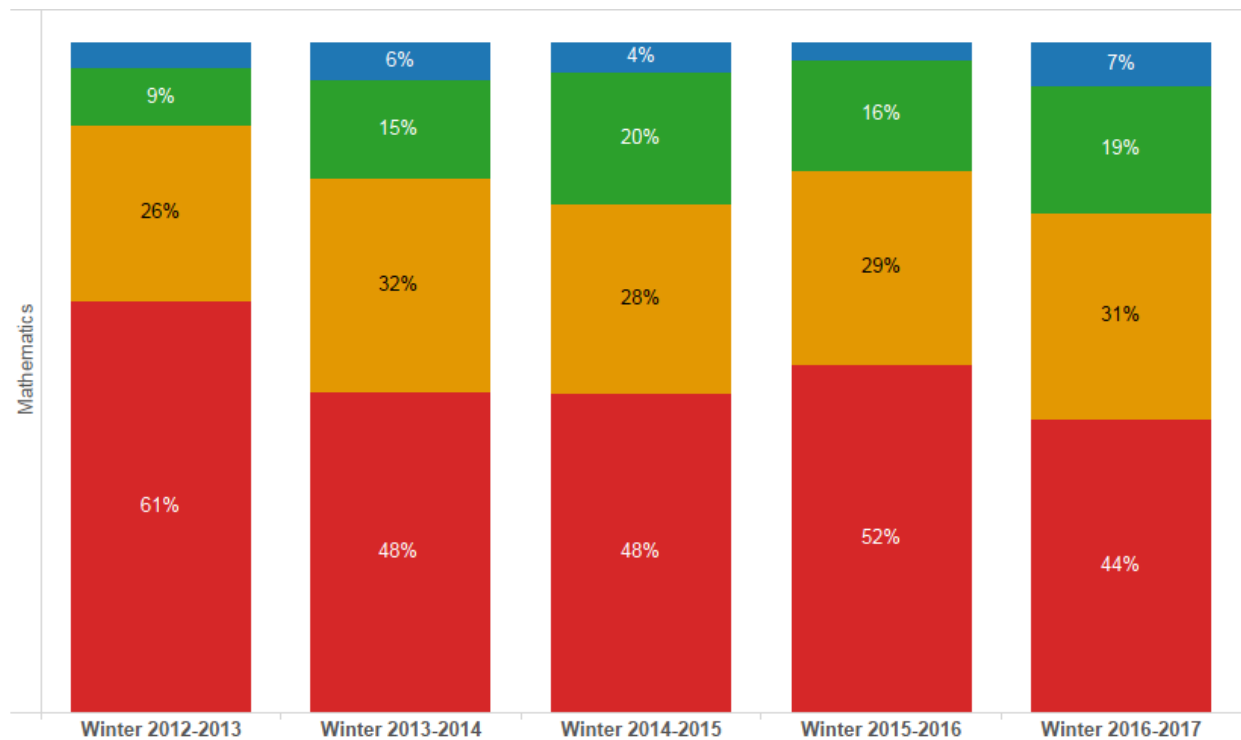
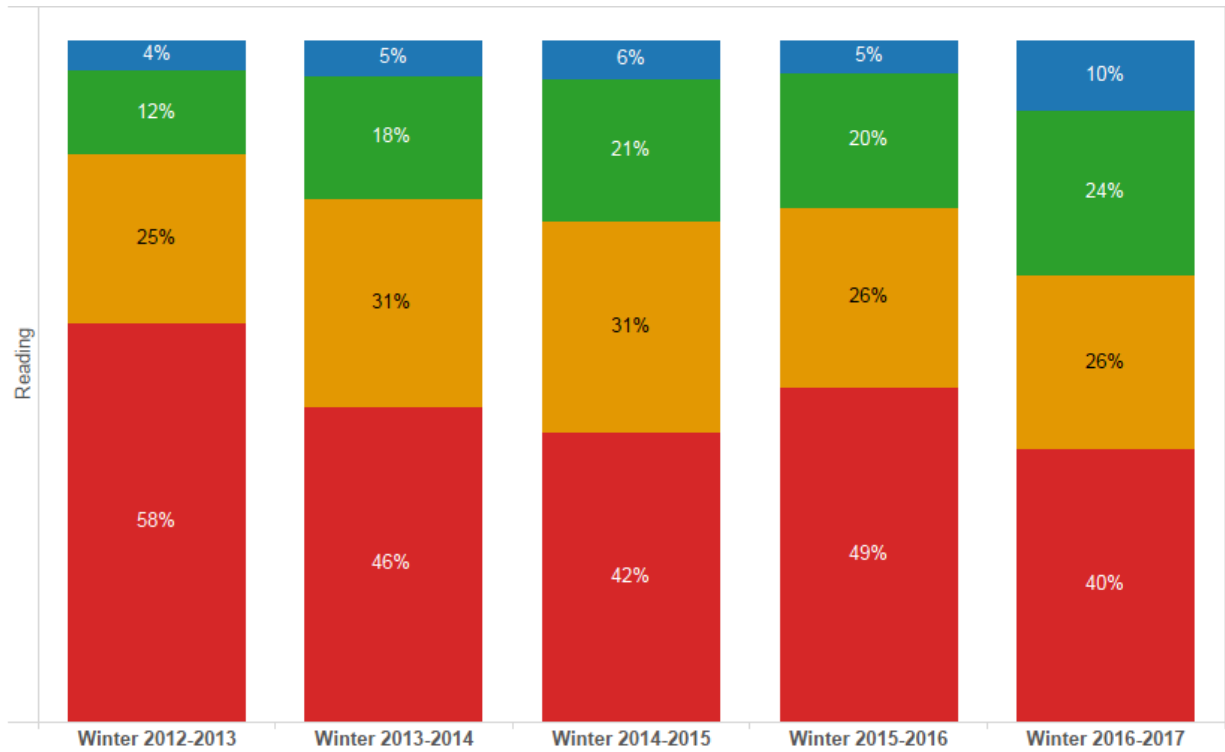
a. Our combined Winter 2017 NWEA percentile is the highest in our history



3. SDA's percentile increase was driven by our best ever fall to winter growth
 - a. Grades 2-8 were in the 53rd percentile for fall to winter math growth
 - b. Grades 2-8 were in the 61st percentile for fall to winter reading growth
 - c. These results show evidence of a dramatic turnaround over the course of the past year



4. SDA has seen a dramatic shift improvement in percentage of students proficient on NWEA.
